- COMPLY WITH ALL LOCAL AND STATE LAWS AND ORDINANCES.
- REFRAIN FROM ENDORSING PRODUCTS FOR PERSONAL GAIN.
- NOT ENGAGE IN OUTSIDE EMPLOYMENT INCONSISTENT WITH THE ETHICAL VIEWS OF THE FIRE SERVICE OR WHICH MAY IMPAIR OUR PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY AS FIRE OFFICERS.
